The candidate will be specifically encouraged to work towards acquiring further academic qualifications. The position involves some teaching at the university.

Ideally, you have already completed your Doctorate and are now seeking to increase your expertise in the research field. Your knowledge of quantitative research methods is above average, and you are also open to investigating qualitative research methods.
